DRESS CODE

The primary purpose of the FLCA dress code is to instill unity among our students. This is in keeping with our "teamwork" guiding principle. As grammar school students we desire for them to be comfortable for learning while beginning to instill modesty and proper personal presentation for the future. With these principles in mind we have established the following as our dress code:

SHIRT: Polo style shirt - any **solid** color. Small logos are acceptable. Long-sleeve polo shirts or long-sleeve t-shirts under the regular polo shirt may be worn in the winter. Examples:



BOTTOMS: Khaki pants, shorts and/or skirts (of modest length) for girls. Style is not the most important thing we just ask that they be some shade of khaki. Belt loops are not required. Examples:



SHOES: Comfortable tennis shoes are recommended. Closed toe and heel are the safest and most appropriate for every day school. Please refrain from wearing flip flops or sandals which may cause injury during outdoor play and learning.

HAIRSTYLES: We ask that students refrain from hairstyles that may be a distraction in the classroom. (ex: unnatural coloring, mohawks, etc.)

No belt is required and shirts do not have to be tucked in.

STUDENTS NOT IN DRESS CODE WILL BE SENT HOME AND MAY RETURN IN PROPER DRESS.
